Examination performance in 2018

GCSE Results 2018

We are pleased with the results of our Y11 students, all of whom now progress to places at ACET post 16, local colleges, apprenticeships and other post 16 providers.

Overall

57% of students gained a 4+ in English and Mathematics combined.

23.13% of the cohort were entered for the English Bacculaureate/Ebacc (Band 4+ in Maths, English, 2x Science, Modern Foreign Language and History or Geography). 61.39% of the Ebacc cohort achieved a band 4+ in these subjects. The academies 23% entry rate into EBacc qualification is in line with all Rotherham schools figure of 23%.

English

64.93% of all students gained a band 4+ in Maths

47.01% of students gained a 5+ and 13.43% gained a 7+ in Maths

58% of students achieved 3+ levels of progress and 20% of students achieved 4+ levels of progress.

Maths

66.42% of all students gained a band 4+ in English

41.04% of students gained a 5+ and 8.21% gained a 7+ in English

66.1% of students achieved 3+ levels of progress and 15.7% of students achieved 4+ levels of progress.

Progress 8 score

The upper progress 8 confidence limit was +0.10 and the lower progress 8 confidence limit was -0.33. This score places the Academy securely within the 'average' category. Categories include above average (2x Rotherham schools), average (9x Rotherham schools), below average (4x Rotherham schools) and well below average (1x Rotherham school).

Post 11 Destination measures

At Swinton Academy we are committed to ensuring that students leave with the necessary skills and qualifications to access post 16 education or training. 2017 data shows that 134 of the 136 (98.5%) students who progressed from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training. 2018 129/134 (96.2%) students progressed from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training. Both figures are well above Rotherham 93% and State funded schools in England 94%
