Examination performance in 2021

GCSE Results 2021

No exams took place in summer 2021 due to the disruption to education caused by coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. To enable students to receive qualifications, it was announced that students who were due to sit A level or GCSE exams in summer 2021 would receive a Teacher Assessed Grade (TAG). For each student, schools have provided a TAG for each subject; this is the grade their teacher believes they would be most likely to have achieved had exams gone ahead, taking into account a range of evidence including, for example, non-exam assessment, classwork, progress to date and mock results in alignment with government guidance.

Students will be able to use the grades they receive in the summer 2021 to move on to their next step.

We are delighted with the results of our Y11 cohort 2021, congratulations to them all.

Overall

74% of students gained a 4+ (standard pass) in English and Mathematics combined. 52% gained a grade 5+ or above in English and Mathematics combined.

43.54% of the cohort were entered for the English Baccalaureate/EBacc. 87.5% of this cohort achieved a band 4+ in this suit of qualifications. 64% of this cohort achieved a grade 5+. The Government refers to this as a 'strong' pass. The academy's 43.54% entry rate into EBacc qualification is above the all Rotherham schools figure for Ebacc entries.

GCSE English Language and Literature.

83% of all students gained a grade 4+ in English

61% of students gained a grade 5+ and 25% gained a grade 7+ in English

This is above national data and the average data for other Rotherham schools.

GCSE Mathematics

80.69% of all students gained a grade 4+ in Maths

59.31% of students gained a grade 5+ and 22.07% gained a 7+ in Maths

This is above both the national and Rotherham averages.

Post 11 Destination measures

At Swinton Academy we are committed to ensuring that students leave with the necessary skills and qualifications to access Post 16 education or training. **2017** data shows that 134 of the 136 (98.5%) students who progressed from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training. In **2018** 129/134 (96.2%) students from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training.

In **2019**, all Y11 students from Swinton Academy successfully progressed into full time education or training. The NEET figure for students leaving in summer **2020** is 1.3%, meaning 98.7% of students successfully entered post 16 education, training or employment. For the Y11 cohort **2021**, 146/147 students successfully entered post 16 education, training or employment one student was classified as NEET (0.7%). We are extremely proud of these successes.

All these figures are well above the Rotherham average of 94.7% in learning and that of State funded schools in England, which is 94% in learning.

Post 16 results 2021

In summer 2021 Swinton Academy had no Y13 Post 16 results. We were delighted to welcome a new Y12 cohort ready to begin qualification in September 2021 and we wish our students moving into Y13 from September 2021 and sitting their final Post 16 exams in summer 2022 the best of luck.
