Examination performance in 2024

Pupils included in this performance data will have experienced some disruption due to Covid-19 earlier in their schooling, which will have affected individual pupils and schools differently.

GCSE Results 2024

Overall

57% of students gained a 4+ (standard pass) in English and Mathematics combined. 33% gained a grade 5+ or above in English and Mathematics combined.

46% of the cohort were entered for the English Baccalaureate/EBacc. 51% of this cohort achieved a band 4+ in this suit of qualifications. 19% of this cohort achieved a grade 5+. The Government refers to this as a 'strong' pass. The percentage of students entered for Ebacc (students who achieve a grade 4+ in English, Maths, Science, a humanity and MFL) is substantially above local authority average and above England average.

Progress 8 Score

Progress 8 score shows how much progress students at Swinton Academy made across 8 qualifications between end of key stage 2 and the end of key stage 4. We have presented this in two measures – value added and contextual value added.

Value added Progress 8 score

-0.23

Measures the progress pupils make over a period of time. Value-added takes into account how much progress a child has made since their starting point (end of KS2), compared to the progress they have made relative to similar pupils.

The schools Progress 8 score places Swinton Academy within the national average Progress 8 score range for all similar schools nationally.

GCSE English Language and Literature.

67% of all students gained a grade 4+ in English

54% of all students gained a grade 5+ in English

15% of all students gained a grade 7+ in English

GCSE Mathematics

64% of all students gained a grade 4+ in Maths

40% of all students gained a grade 5+ in Maths

8% of all students gained a grade 7+ in Maths

Post 11 Destination measures

At Swinton Academy we are committed to ensuring that students leave with the necessary skills and qualifications to access Post 16 education or training. **2024** data shows that 163 of the 181 (89%) students who progressed from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training. In **2023** 176/177 (99.4%) students from Y11 at Swinton Academy went into full time education or training. Swinton Academy listed one student as NEET, 0.56% of the entire cohort. We are extremely proud that our Y11 students have been successful in pursuing post 16 qualifications and courses. Rotherham Early Help teams along with the academy careers lead continue to support any Swinton Academy students who require support accessing post 16 education, employment or training.
